Legion MC, in conjunction with Four Horsemen Charities, Inc., is pleased to announce Legion MC's 2015 Giving Back event. The event will take place on Saturday, June 27, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. at the Woodstock Inn in Woodstock, Maryland. Our goal is to raise money for three Veteran-related, non-profit organizations:

- Wounded Warrior Project. The purpose of this organization is to raise awareness and to enlist the public's aid for the needs of injured service members, to help injured servicemen and women aid and assist each other, and to provide unique, direct programs and services to meet their needs. WWP currently serves more than 60,000 warriors and nearly 9,000 family members through more than 20 unique programs and services. WWP was the designated charity for Legion's 2013 fundraising event, and we are honored to have the opportunity to once again offer support.
- The Travis Manion Foundation. The Travis Manion Foundation is a 501(c)(3) honoring the fallen by challenging the living. The not-for-profit assists our nation's veterans and service members, and supports the families of fallen heroes.
- 22 Needs a Face. This non-profit organization exists to combat against the number of service member suicides within the United States. The Department of Veterans recently estimated that every day 22 service members succumb to Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and seek to end the pain in their own lives. 22 Needs a Face seeks to raise awareness of Veteran suicides and to educate the public on methods to overcome symptoms of PTSD and Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) in order to prevent Veteran suicides and make alternative therapies available to Veterans with PTSD and TBI.

Registration for the Legion MC's Giving Back 2015 is \$25.00 per person, which will include an event t-shirt, continental breakfast, a two hour ride and admission to the after party with live music, raffles and food.
